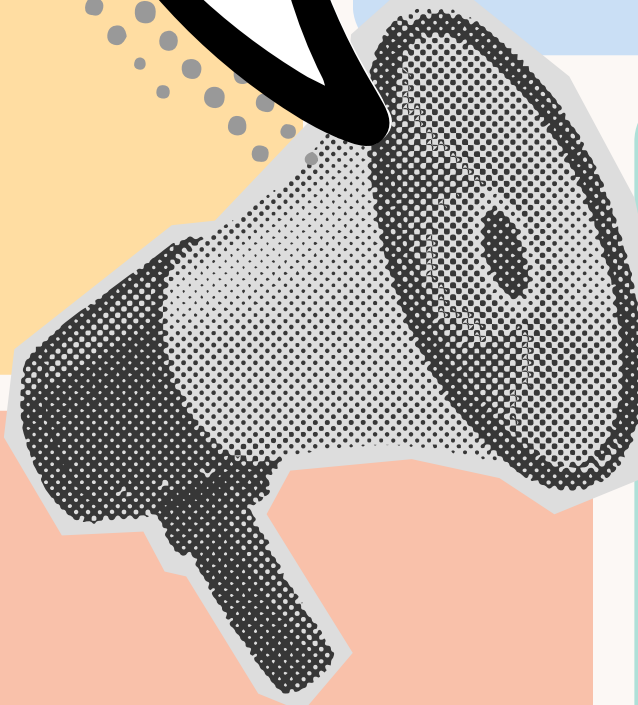

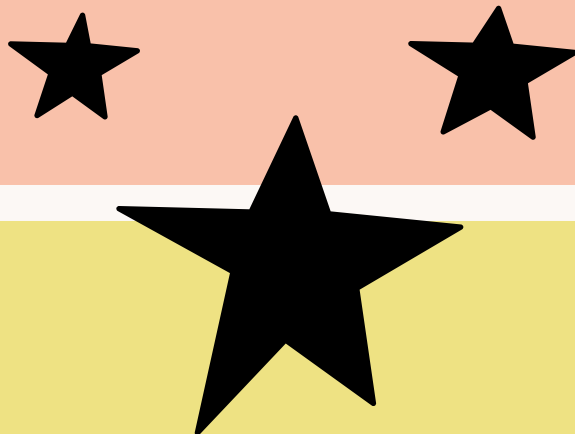

LIFE SKILLS FUNDING

Young Adults on an eligible Youth Transitions agreement who are pursuing life skills related goals can apply for:

Life skills, Training, and Cultural Connections Funding (LSTCC): Covers a yearly maximum of \$5500 (with an overall maximum of \$11,000)



HOUSING

Housing Agreement (SHA): Supports Young Adults to remain in their homes after 19. Available to eligible young adults (aged 19-21) for up to 24 months.

Support Agreement (SSA): Supports living expenses for young adults transitioning to independent living. Available to eligible Young Adults (aged 19-21) for up to 24 months.

Rent Supplement: \$600/month (for up to 24 months) eligible to Young Adults (aged 19-27*) living in private market rental housing in B.C. Applications are accepted twice per year.

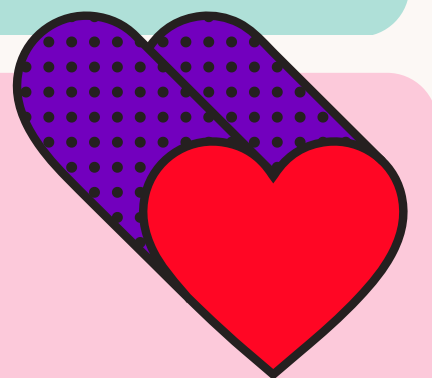
INCOME SUPPORTS

Unconditional Income Support Agreement (UISA): Eligible Young Adults (aged 19-20) can receive up to \$1250 monthly income support to help cover living expenses.

Conditional Income Support Agreement (CISA): Young Adults (aged 20-27*) participating in an eligible education, training, rehabilitation, and/or life skills program can receive up to \$1250 of monthly support.

HEALTH AND WELLNESS



Opportunities to nurture culture, community and connection.

Young Adults on an eligible agreement are eligible for enrollment in **extended health benefits with Pacific Blue Cross.**
